Frequently Asked Questions

Is Grasshopper Soccer a soccer club?

No. Grasshopper Soccer is a non-competitive soccer organisation focusing on skill development and having fun.

What age groups are involved in the programs?

Our programs are run for children aged 4-12. Our after school programs and weekend programs cater for children aged 2-12.

What do you offer?

Grasshopper Soccer offers a wide range of programs including:

After School Programs: starts straight after school finishes.

Weekend Programs: as the name suggests. Weekday Programs: starts later in the afternoon to allow for travel time. <u>Holiday Prog</u>rams

In-school programs: lunch time, curriculum. We do Before school Programs.

Who coaches the children/students?

All programs are conducted by coaches that have been trained by Grasshopper Soccer.

What are the costs to the parents and school?

The school bears no cost in allowing Grasshopper Soccer to conduct a program on the grounds. All advertising and collection of enrolments is handled by Grasshopper Soccer, as well as assignment of coach's. Parents pay a fee prior to the program starting that will cover them for that terms program.

Do you need a sporting facility?

All our programs are conducted outside on an oval or a field. Our request to the school would be to have permission to use their school oval and undercover area if in the event of inclement weather.

Are Grasshopper Soccer coach's police checked and do they have a working with children card?

All of our coach's are required to have a police clearance and working with children card before they can start working for Grasshopper Soccer. Is Grasshopper Soccer covered by insurance?

Grasshopper Soccer has a \$10 million public liability insurance, plus \$10 million products liability insurance and \$2 million professional indemnity insurance.

What are your coaching ratios?

The coaching ratio for a Grasshopper Soccer program is 1:14 children maximum, however can be less than this if the age range varies.

What about age differences in classes?

All children of similar age and ability will be put together and separated, even if the number of students is below the coaching ratio.

How will Grasshopper Soccer impact after care programs?

Our programs will not affect any aftercare program that you may have running at your school. Grasshopper Soccer programs are run separately to any school curriculum and are paid for by the parents of participating students. Grasshopper Soccer is also happy to escort any child that has to go to after school care once the session has finished.

What happens in wet/hot weather?

Grasshopper Soccer will run in wet weather if it has access to an undercover area and will play in light rain. If the weather is deemed to be too severe, the session will be cancelled and re-scheduled to another day.

Grasshopper Soccer will run in hot weather and will allow children plenty of drink breaks and rest in the shade. If there is access to an undercover area, this will be used in extreme circumstances. Where do children meet the coaches?

Children will meet the coach in a designated spot as stated on the enrolment form, this is usually the school oval.

Are there other schools involved with Grasshopper Soccer?


Yes, Grasshopper Soccer run's these programs successfully at many different schools across Australia
